JOB DESCRIPTION

I. Position Title: Gang Mower Operator

Reports To: Park Maintenance Foreman
Director of Parks, Recreation & Forestry Department

II. Job Summary:

This position involves the operation and maintenance of a 16ft lawnmower or 10.5ft lawnmower. Duties include the operation of a large riding lawn mower to cut in various Village parks and public areas. Operator must be able to get on and off mower frequently to pickup garbage and move picnic tables. Operator is also responsible for the daily routine maintenance and cleaning of the mower. Position typically runs late April through October depending on weather and grass growth. Average of 24 to 32 hours/week, depending on weather & grass growth.

III. Duties & Responsibilities:

The following duties are normal for this position. These are not to be construed as exclusive or all-inclusive and other duties may be required and assigned.

- A. Ability to operate a large riding mower.
- B. Ability to get on and off mower frequently to pick up garbage and move picnic tables.
- C. Responsible for daily maintenance and cleaning of mower.
- D. Able to work with little or no direct supervision.
- E. Ability to process and follow morning work list throughout the day.
- F. Other duties as assigned.

IV. Knowledge, Skills & Abilities:

- Must be 21 years of age and posses a valid Wisconsin drivers license with good driving record.
- Ability to communicate effectively with residents and co-workers in a courteous and helpful manner.
- Be able to work independently with little or no supervision.
- Ability to lift and maneuver 100 pounds.
- Ability to perform heavy manual labor involving occasional bending, lifting, stooping and climbing.
- Ability to operate vehicles, lawn mowers, string trimmers, small tractors and various hand tools.
- Ability to tolerate working in varying weather conditions.

V. Desirable Training and Experience:

- Knowledge and skill in park and public lands maintenance.
- Ability to operate large riding mower.
- Completion of Blood Borne Pathogen Training provided by the Department

VI. General Expectations:

- Demonstrate authority when circumstances warrant. If needed, contact Park Maintenance Foreman for assistance.
- Personal grooming and dress should be clean in taste, no rips or holes in jeans/pants.
